

There was not much original material included in this text. I would describe it as a "meta analysis" of best practices for healthcare leaders. One of the best features of this book is that the end of each chapter contains references to books for future study about the topic discussed in the chapter. To that end, the majority of the books recommended in the book are also great reads.
