

More than a identification guide, this steel-spiral bound book explores how plants fit into the daily life of wetlands. Covering an area generally from Canada to Florida, between the Missisippi and East coast, it describes how plants interact with insects, mammals, reptiles, people, and so on. It is not a complete flora, but it was not meant to be. The entries read like nature center or museum displays; plain English, but still with enough technical features to make a confident ID. The book includes a glossary, species list for interacting organisms, and field forms to record observations on specific plants. 394 pages.
