

She somehow manages to take a bunch of fairly unremarkable, usual characters and give them what starts out as an ordinary story, but with one unique twist, turns them into extraordinary books. I am guaranteed to need tissues and want a hug after finishing a book by her, but I always feel I am a better person for having read the story she has given me.You get all of the above with I Was Here with the exception of needing

tissues and wanting a hug. This book left me cold; I know that is a pretty blunt summation, but thatâ [™]s how I felt. I am not sure what went wrong but for me there was no emotion from me or the characters, I felt no empathy or sympathy for what any of them were experiencing, and I could find no real solid reasoning for half of the things Cody did, thought or said. I would go as far as to say disliked her, her mother, their attitudes and just them in general intensely.Ben didnâ [™]t evoke much from me either, in fact no one in the book did really, apart from Megâ [™]s little brother Scottie. Megâ [™]s suicide and the reasoning behind it, her familyâ [™]s behavior in the aftermath, and the actions Cody took to try and get to the bottom of the mysteryâ | nothing.
